Amenities:

- Leasing practitioners are required to be certified, insured and/or licensed in their field of therapeutic practice.
- When available and agreeable, practitioner suites may be shared through sub-lease contracts with a principal practitioner in long-term contract.
- A minimum leasing contract is six months and includes:
 - A professional, personal description on the HH&W website in the Practitioner section, including photograph and logos (web listings have a monthly *web maintenance fee*)
 - A brief description of services/techniques/therapies on the HH&W website in the Mind/Body Practice(s) section
 - Professional signage space: (space provided by HH&W; printing and installation paid by leaser and provided by King Signs)
 - Main Front Sign on Broadfoot Avenue
